### Positive institutional accreditation of Aalborg University

On 21 June 2018, the Accreditation Council granted Aalborg University a **positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act<sup>1</sup>.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 21 June 2024, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
